RealEase is pleased to announce the second generation software version 2.0 for Shogo and upgrading of the service portal www.myshogo.com. With the latest version 2.0 software, Shogo again set the new benchmark for internet enabled digital photo frame.

What's new in version 2.0?

- Brand new user interface that makes browsing and viewing of your digital content much faster and easier.
- View the content of your albums in thumbnail mode.
- View your albums slideshows in random sequence.
- A new facebook channel has been added to the myShogo.com web site allowing Shogo users to select from their favorite photo albums in their facebook account. These photos are then automatically sent over the Internet to the designated Shogo
- The new Shogo Photo Mail feature enables the Shogo to automatically receive photos sent to any email address. These photos will be instantly and automatically available on the Shogo frame.
- Support "private" albums and images in Flickr and picasa. You can now keep your photos private, and still be able to share them with Shogo frames.

What is the Improvement?

- Improved connectivity to wireless networks (WiFi).
- Supports MP3 files that can be stored and played.

New features in myShogo.com web portal include:

- Photo Viewing & Sharing:
 - Shogo Photo Mail – capture photos from your personal email account
 - Photo sharing channel including integration with Picasa (Google), MobileMe (Apple), Flickr (Yahoo), SmugMug, and RSS feeds
- Social Networking:
 - New FaceBook channel on www.myShogo.com
- Weather:
 - Display 6-day forecasts, single or multiple city weather on your Shogo.
- Music:
 - Access to over 2,000 plus Internet radio stations, which can be sorted by genre, country and language, and streamed to a Shogo

How to upgrade?

Select “Settings”, go up with the up arrow, choose “system upgrade”, and press the Yellow button. It will take 5 to 15 minutes to perform an upgrade, please make sure that your network is connected and do not power off during the upgrade. It is always preferable to connect your Shogo on Ethernet for system upgrade and to keep it connected to the power adaptor rather than running on battery. At the end of the upgrade, Shogo will re-boot automatically, it shows that upgrade is successfully done.

What if it doesn't work?

An error message will show up if the upgrade doesn't work. First check that you have connected to the power adaptor and your AC power is ON. Check your WiFi connectivity (check the WiFi signal level, make sure you have the highest signal level); or connect to Ethernet with Ethernet cable. Re-do the upgrade process again.
